

INSTRUMENTAL TEACHERS

We work with the music company Symphony Music. They provide a variety of specialist teachers who attend the school each week for varying amounts of time. They are experienced and professional teachers who are professional musicians and thus offer much expertise and inspiration to our students.

LESSON STRUCTURE

Lessons occur weekly during class time and lunchtimes. Lessons are private/individual or shared. The lesson times change each week so students don't miss the same class. Timetables are emailed to parents and students and posted in the notices.

INSTRUMENTS

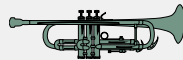
OLC has some instruments for use, but these are limited.

An ensemble fee of \$80 per term will be charged. Students must have a minimum of 2 year's experience.

Lessons are undertaken on a term by term basis. Students cannot withdraw part way through the term.
